- € **"JUST IN TIME" VOLUNTEERING** [Chair: Char Yotz, Volunteer Coordinator] Your name will go onto a special Volunteer Email List. When the PTSA or school need volunteers, the Volunteer Coordinator will send out a "Call for Volunteers" email to everyone on the list. If you have the time and ability to help, reply to the email. If you can't help out at that time, simply delete the email.
- € **ADVOCACY** [Chair: Liz Piekarczyk] Help educate and motivate members to carry out the Washington State PTA mission to be advocates for all students. Stay informed about legislative issues, write letters and make calls to legislators on behalf of issues that impact our children.
- € **BAKING/PROVIDING FOOD** [Chair: Char Yotz, Volunteer Coordinator] Provide food for staff appreciation and meetings, PTSA meetings, events, etc.
- € **CAMPUS CLEAN-UP** [Chair: Kristin Minner] Help clean up and beautify the campus by cleaning, painting, gardening, etc. Some projects include coordination with the Horticulture Department and students to make an even bigger impact.
- € **DANCE SUPPORT** [Chair: Marsheila Kenow] Assist in supporting school dances. May include chaperoning, coat check, etc.
