What to Expect:

SAT practice test sessions — Students will do a condensed version of an official SAT practice test, score their tests for instant feedback, and receive guided analysis of their results to help determine their areas of strengths and weaknesses. A light snack will be provided.

SAT/ACT prep courses — Students will become familiar with test directions, the types of questions, and learn various test-taking strategies. Students will receive regular homework and practice tests to complete at home. Course size: maximum of 30 students per course (a minimum of 8 students must register for a course to run).
